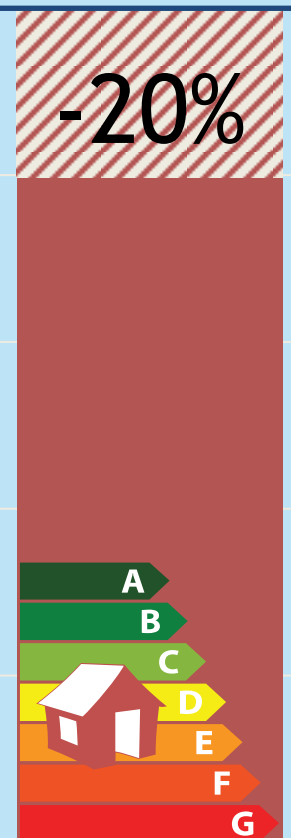
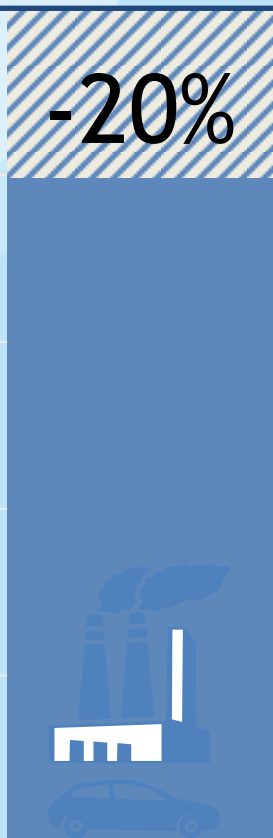

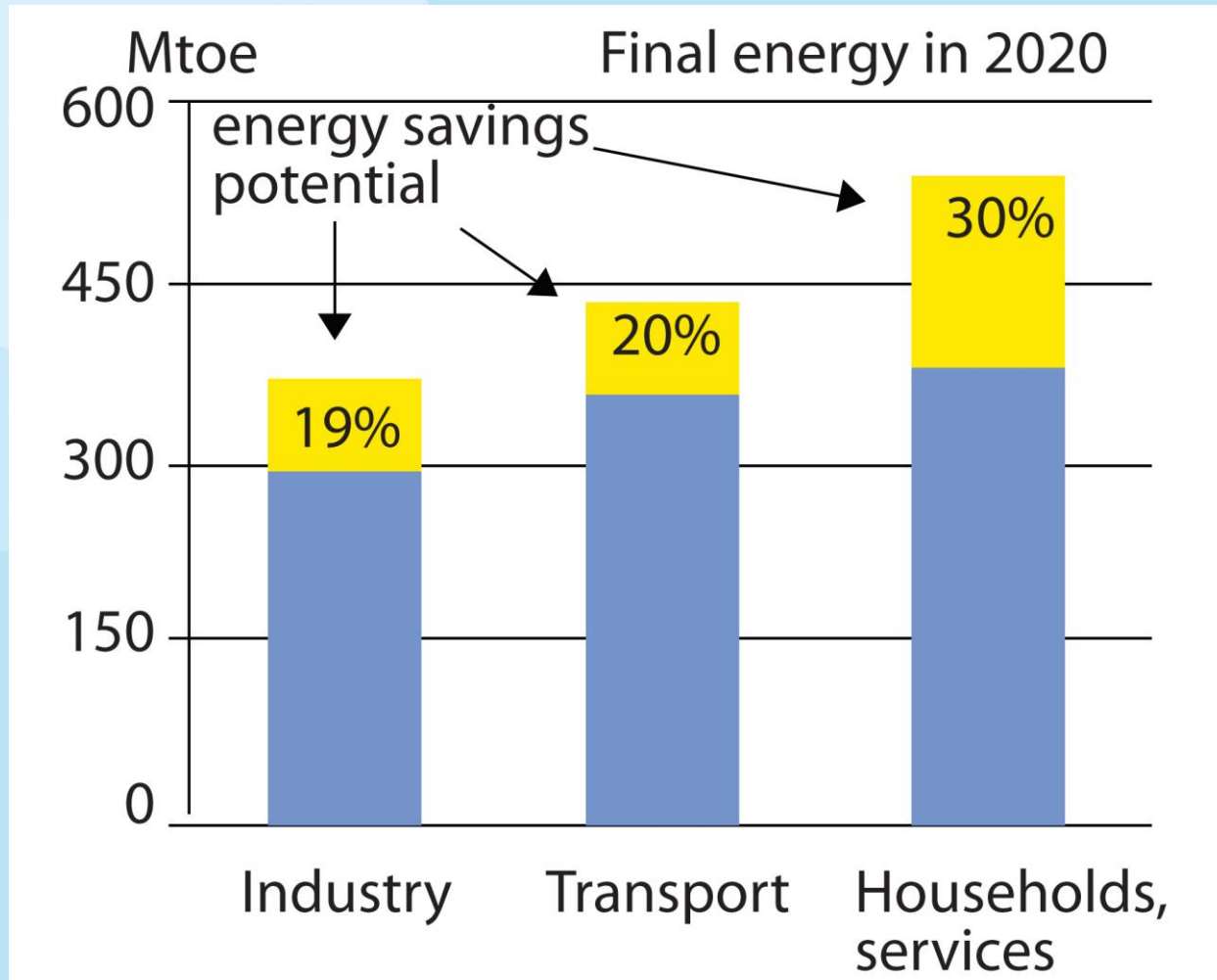

- > €730 million programme (2007-13)
- > Funding projects through annual calls for proposals
- > 75% funding support (grants)

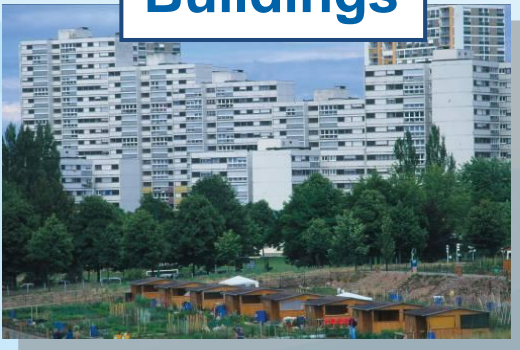

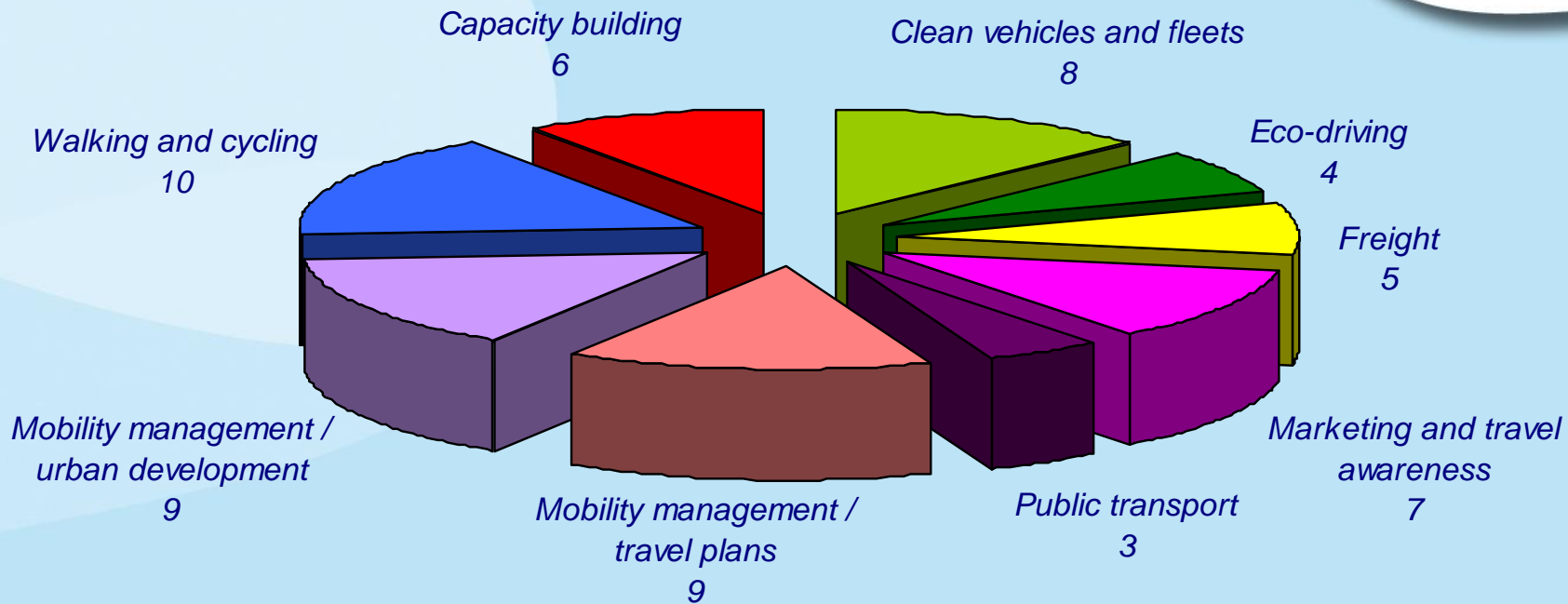
